Dear Brenham Country Club Members,

Thank you for being part of Brenham Country Club. This place is what it is because of the people who choose to be here, and I appreciate each of you. As your newly appointed President, I'm honored to serve and want you to know that my focus is always on what's best for the membership as a whole.

### **Immediate Items We're Addressing:**

There are a few operational needs that require quick attention, and we're already moving on them:

- **Course ice machine** — Scheduled for replacement this spring to keep service consistent for golfers and events.
- **Walk-in cooler condenser** — At the end of its life and needs to be replaced soon to keep the kitchen running.
- **Septic system repairs** — A significant project that we're working through carefully so it's handled responsibly and efficiently.

**Rising fertilizer and chemical costs** — Prices have continued to increase over the last two years, and we're reviewing options to manage these increases while maintaining course conditions.

**Looking Ahead at Member Priorities**— Many of you completed our recent survey, and your feedback was extremely helpful. It gave us a clear picture of what matters most to you. While we can't take on everything at once, we do have an eye on the items you identified. As we work through the immediate needs listed above, we'll also begin chipping away at several of the priorities you highlighted. Steady, visible progress is important, and that's what we're aiming for.

I'm always available to visit—whether you see me around the club, on the course, or want to reach out by phone or email. If you have questions, concerns, or ideas, I'm glad to talk anytime.

As you can see, tournament season is in full swing at the Club. I, on occasion, hear comments relating to the use of our facilities by the High School Golf Team and Blinn College for practice, play, and tournaments. These young people are learning the game of golf and many are passionate about the sport. We are fortunate to have Earl Hathaway and Tara Felder as the High School Golf Coaches, and Kari Prihoda as the Junior High School Golf Coach, along with David Johnson and Gary Belt, our Blinn Coaches, who are encouraging these students, teaching them golf etiquette, and helping them with learning the skills to play golf. The coaches also have the students occasionally help with maintenance on the course doing such tasks as filling in divots and raking range balls away from the net and under the trees, etc. It is often the case that many of these students become members of our club after they have graduated from school and begin their careers. The school also hosts a minimum of 4 high school tournaments a year which bring in additional tournament fees, cart rentals, drinks, snacks, and merchandise sales. I feel it helpful to share this information with our membership and we hope that, as members, you will be a source of encouragement and show patience with these young people who are doing something positive and are hopefully lifelong golfers.

**On another note, by popular demand, we have added a hot dog machine in the Pro Shop. We have already begun hot dog sales with hot dogs available all day starting at 9:30am.**

Springtime is the time of year when we start bringing in new members. We are ready! Our course is in great shape, the bar and grill are open, and the pool will open on May 1st. So, ask a friend, co-worker or family member to join you at the Club. If you see someone new in the coming months please make them feel welcome and make a new friend! 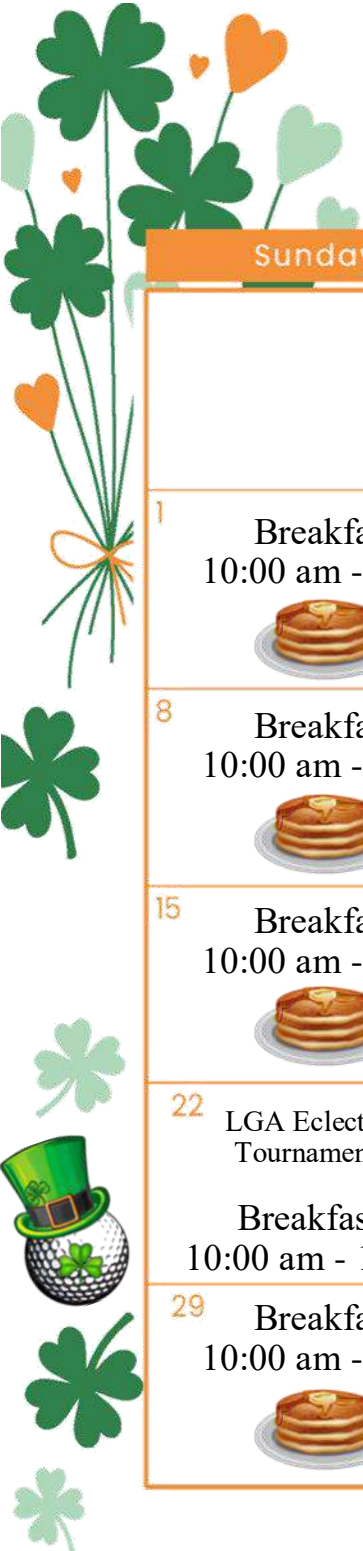

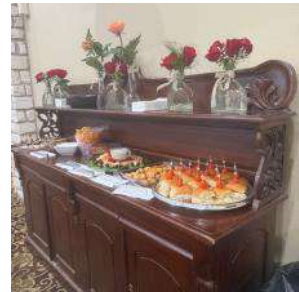
