Dear Members,

The course is beginning to show encouraging signs as we move deeper into spring. Rising temperatures are helping suppress the poa annua, and the new reels installed on the greens mower are already producing a noticeably cleaner and more consistent cut. The recent rainfall, while inconvenient at the time, will ultimately benefit the bermuda, allowing the fairways to thicken and the greens to regain their full color and health.

In addition, our new club-management software is now fully implemented and represents a significant upgrade for both members and staff. Those who have not yet logged in, are encouraged to review recent emails for instructions on accessing the system and exploring its improved features.

Even with this positive momentum, it is important to acknowledge the challenges that contributed to a difficult start to the season. Early in the year, the poa annua advanced more aggressively than normal, primarily because it showed resistance to the herbicide used to control it. Shortly afterward, we received six inches of rain during the same week our greens-aeration equipment was scheduled. The extended wet conditions prevented mowing for several days, and these setbacks occurred while we were also preparing for several major tournaments. Compounding the situation, we experienced the loss of five maintenance staff members, reducing the manpower needed during one of the busiest periods of the year.

Aeration was completed, though not without incident. Many of you noticed the damage on hole #7, where the machine pulled up sections of sod while operating. José is actively repairing the affected areas, but it will take some time for the turf to fully recover and for the



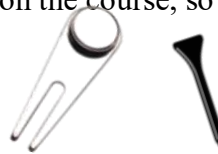

Greeting Members,

This months installment of the Marshall Minute will cover divot and pitch mark repair. I must add as a membership group, y'all do an outstanding job of this. We have witnessed many of our members repairing their own as well as others out on the course, so keep it up, it really makes a difference.

The information below is more for our newer members.



Properly repairing ball marks and divots is crucial for course health, as a neglected ball mark can take three weeks to heal. To repair a ball mark (pitch mark), use a tool or tee to push the surrounding turf inward toward the center, then tap it level with a putter; do not lift or pry the roots. Divots should be replaced if intact, or filled with sand/soil mix, ensuring they are level with the surrounding turf.

#### **Repairing Ball Marks on the Green**

- **Method:** Insert your repair tool, or tee into the turf outside the edge of the depression.
- **Push:** Push the turf inward toward the center. Repeat this around all sides.
- **Never Pry:** Do not lift the center of the ball mark up, as this breaks the roots and creates dead, brown spots.
- **Finish:** Tap the area smooth with your putter to ensure a smooth surface for putting.
- **Tip:** Fix your own mark plus one other, as this helps keep the green in good condition.

#### **Repairing Divots on the Course**

- **Intact Divot:** If the turf is still attached to the roots, replace it in the divot, ensure it is oriented correctly, and press it down firmly with your foot to encourage rooting.
- **Exploded/Missing Divot:** Fill the hole with the provided sand/seed mix (divot mix) until it is slightly below the surrounding turf level, then smooth with your foot.
- **Avoid Overfilling:** Too much sand can damage mower blades .

Thanks again for your continued contribution to the Country Club and we will see y'all on the course.
