MARSHALL MINUTES

This edition of the Marshall Minutes will be about raking bunkers the correct way. We may not have many bunkers to contend with but here is the proper way to rake them.

Raking a sand trap (bunker) properly maintains the course and ensures fair play for everyone.

Always enter and exit from the low side of the bunker. Erase all footprints and divots using long, smooth raking motions while walking backward out of the trap, and leave the rake flat outside the bunker.

Step-by-Step Raking:

1. Prepare to enter: Grab the rake before you get into the bunker to avoid walking through the disturbed sand twice.
2. Smooth the damage: Walk to your footprints and the area where your ball was played. If there are deep holes from your feet, briefly step them flat before raking.
3. Rake smoothly: Use long, sweeping pulls as you back away toward the edge. Avoid quick, jerky motions. For significant bumps, use the back (flat) side of the rake to level the area before using the teeth.
4. Blend the edges: Do not pull sand out of the trap onto the grass. As you reach the perimeter, lightly smooth the edge of your footsteps with the flat side of the rake.
5. Clean up: Tap any excess sand off your shoes before stepping onto the green.

Rake Placement:

When you finish, the placement of the rake depends on the specific golf course's policy. If you are unsure, place the rake flat on the ground just outside the bunker, parallel to the line of play so it will not interfere with any incoming golf balls.
