As a reminder, the Food Minimum begins August 1, 2026. All Grill purchases made during the month will be recorded on your account, whether you pay at the time of purchase or charge them to your account.

- If you purchase \$20 of food, you will be billed the remaining \$10.00
- If you purchase \$35, you will not receive a minimum charge.

MARSHALL MINUTES

Recently we have had some issues with members following rules that are intended to keep the course in good shape. These rules are not arbitrary—they exist to protect the turf, prevent long-term damage, and ensure that both members and guests enjoy the best possible playing conditions.

Cart Path Only Means Cart Path Only

Some members know the course extremely well. They know which areas dry out quickly and which spots stay soft. But the public does not. When a member decides to leave the cart path because *they* believe the ground is dry enough, every guest watching assumes they can do the same. And once one cart leaves the path, others follow. The result is preventable damage that takes days or weeks to repair.

Cart Path Only is not optional. It applies to everyone—members, guests, and staff—every time it is in effect.

Our marshals do their best, but they cannot be everywhere. **It is up to us, the members, to be marshals too.** Your example sets the tone for every group behind you. When you follow the rules, others follow the rules. When you don't, others assume they don't have to either.

The 90-Degree Rule: What It Actually Means

We are also seeing ongoing confusion about the **90-degree rule**. Driving straight down the middle of the fairway is *not* the 90-degree rule.

The correct procedure is simple:

- Stay on the cart path until you are **even with your ball**
- Turn **straight in at a right angle**
- Take the **shortest route** to your ball
- Hit your shot
- Return **straight back** to the path

The 90-degree rule is designed to limit wear patterns—not create new ones. Cutting across fairways or driving the full length of them defeats the purpose entirely.

Again, our marshals cannot monitor every hole at all times. **We, the members, must help uphold the standard by modeling it.** The course stays healthier when everyone follows the same rules.

Setting the Example

Whether it's Cart Path Only or the 90-degree rule, the expectation is the same:

Follow the rules as they are written, not as you personally interpret them.

Your leadership on the course matters. Your choices influence guests. And your example directly impacts the condition of Brenham Country Club.

Thank you for doing your part to protect the course and uphold the standards that make our club a place we're proud to play.
