*the High School Golf Team for practice, play, and tournaments. These young people are learning the game of golf and many are passionate about the sport. We are fortunate to have Earl Hathaway, Tara Felder, and Kari Prihoda as the Golf Coaches who are encouraging these students, teaching them golf etiquette, and helping them with learning the skills to play golf. The coaches also have the students occasionally help with maintenance on the course doing such tasks as filling in divots, etc. It is often the case that many of these students become members of our club after they have graduated from school and begin their careers. The school also hosts a minimum of 4 high school tournaments a year which bring in a minimum of \$15,000 in green fees, cart rentals, drinks, snacks, and merchandise sales. In addition, the Friends of Golf Tournament brought in an additional \$13,000 of income to the club this year. The Friends of Golf, a couple of years ago, additionally paid in full for the installation of the practice putting green located adjacent to the driving range. I just felt it would be helpful to share this information with our membership and we hope that, as members, you will be a source of encouragement and show patience with these young people who are doing something positive and are hopefully lifelong golfers.*

*On another note, the Grill is open Tuesday thru Sunday from 11:00am to 3:00pm and we are serving delicious burgers and fries, sandwiches and more. In addition, the Bar is open 11:00am to close on these days as well. I invite you to drop by for lunch and your favorite beverage this weekend!*

*We will also hold our Annual Easter Egg Hunt and Breakfast on Saturday, March 23<sup>rd</sup>. The breakfast will start at 9:00am with the Easter Egg Hunt starting at 9:45am. Cost for the event will be \$18.95 per person, covering the cost of breakfast and Easter Eggs.*

## CREDIT POLICY

**Accounts 30 days past due** will have their charging privileges suspended until their account is paid in full. Once the past due balance is paid, charging privileges will be re-extended.

**Accounts 60 days past due** will be posted and members will not be allowed to use any Club facilities until their account is paid in full. Once the past due balance is paid, charging privileges will be re-extended.

# Brenham CC Hole-In-One Club

Are you one of the fortunate few who will make a Hole-In-One? If so, this is your opportunity to celebrate with some cash benefits. . .

## Membership

Open to all golf members of BCC. There is no charge to join, but the member must declare the free membership at least one full day before the occurrence of a hole in one.

## Qualifications

The Hole-in-One Club member:

- Must be involved in at least an 18 hole round
- Must be playing with at least one witness
- If playing a format that allows a second shot, "mulligan", they must make the ace on the first ball
- A practice round of at least 18 holes would qualify if made on the first ball
- Players must be playing from any regulation tee

## Rewards

Will receive credit for 1/2 the amount generated by the billing of all the members of the Hole-in-One Club. The amount per member is fixed at \$5. The proceeds will be applied to the credit account on the first day of the second month after the achievement. This is to allow most of the funds to have been collected from the members. "Celebration" beverages for all club members will be made available for 2 hours at the Bar. The credit awarded to the member can be used in the Pro Shop for merchandise of a cart rental, and/or for food and beverage charges.

## Costs

As stated, when the Ace occurs, the other members of the club will be billed \$5.00 on the 26th on the month. Hopefully, some of the members will be among those helping the lucky person celebrate.
