along with David Johnson and Gary Belt, our Blinn Coaches, who are encouraging these students, teaching them golf etiquette, along with learning the skills to play golf. The coaches also have the students occasionally help with maintenance on the course doing such tasks as filling in divots and raking range balls away from the net and under the trees, etc. It is often the case that many of these students become members of our club after they have graduated from school and begin their careers. The High School also hosts a minimum of 4 tournaments a year and Blinn hosts 2 tournaments a year, which brings in additional tournament fees, cart rentals, drinks, snacks, and merchandise sales. I feel it helpful to share this information with our membership and we hope that, as members, you will be a source of encouragement and show patience with these young people who are doing something positive and are hopefully lifelong golfers.
