Dear Members,

As I am sure you have all heard, Mike Kullberg, our Golf Professional is no longer with us. After careful consideration it was concluded that it was in the Club's best interest to proceed without his services. We are currently searching for a new PGA Head Golf Professional and plan to fill the position as soon as possible. In the interim, Tim Thelen from Sterling Golf has graciously agreed to serve as the Acting Head Professional for the next thirty days.

Work has started up again on our Pro Shop. The plan is to be up and running in about 4 weeks!



With the beautiful spring weather we have been having lately, play has gone up overnight. Please follow good golf etiquette as suggested whenever you play with us at the Brenham Country Club:

**-Play Ready Golf.** Be prepared to play when it is your turn, minimizing delays.

**-Respect the course.** Avoid damaging the grass, greens or other areas.

\*Keep your cart at least 30 ft from the greens at all times (handicap flags, too).

\*DO NOT drive on the tee boxes.

\*ALL CARTS (Handicap included) must remain on the cart path when we are cart path only!

\*Fill your divots with **green sand** from the green sand boxes. We have divot tools for sale in the pro shop.

\*Rake the Bunkers. Smooth out the sand after playing from a bunker to maintain its condition for other players.

All these practices will help keep our course alive and in good shape.

**- Dress Appropriately.** Wear golf appropriate attire, showing respect for the game and the course.

**- Show Courtesy to Fellow Golfers.** Don't talk or make noise while someone is swinging. Maintain silence and avoid distractions during a player's swing.

- **Be Mindful of Other Players.** Be aware of where players are and avoid walking in front of them or in their line of play.
- **Practice Good Sportsmanship.** Show respect for your opponents and the game, even if you're not playing your best.
- **Keep Phones on Silent or Off.** Avoid using phones during a round of golf, as they can be distracting.
- **Know the Rules.**
  - \* Familiarize Yourself with the Rules of Golf
  - \* Be Honest and Ethical
  - ◆ Resolve Any Disputes Respectfully.

- **Cart Etiquette.**

Adhere to Course Rules - Follow any specific rules regarding cart use, such as designated routes or restricted areas.

Drive Safely - Operate the cart safely and responsibly, avoiding damage to the course or injury to others. Don't drive on Greens or Tees - Avoid driving carts on these areas, as it can damage the turf.

By adhering to these simple principles, golfers can contribute to a more enjoyable and respectful experience for everyone on the course.

Since we are on the topic of etiquette I would like to talk more about cart etiquette. In the past month we have had 3 different incidents where children under the age of 16 were driving personal carts and had accidents. One cart hit and damaged a parked car, one backed into a tree and one cart turned over. Luckily, to my knowledge, no one was hurt. Due to these incidents, we are in the process of writing a cart policy to be signed by all members who have personal carts on the BCC grounds. Personal safety is our first concern here at the Club. Going forward, all cart drivers must be 16 years of age and hold a current driver's license, whether driving a personal cart or a BCC cart.
