
As you have probably heard, Golf Professional Steven Drew decided not to come to Brenham after all. We have several new candidates we are talking with and hope to have a new golf pro soon.

As you have probably seen, we are doing major work on our driving range, taking out the different tee box levels and extending concrete at the very top to allow for mats all the way across the range. Friends of Golf and our Men's Golf Association are both donating \$7,000 for a total of \$14,000 to put towards the leveling of tee boxes and the regrassing of the project. The Club will cover the cost of the concrete under the mats.

Another topic of discussion is the cart policy. For safety and insurance reasons, the Board voted at the May Board Meeting for all golf cart driver's to be over the age of 16 AND have a valid driver's license. We have had a number of underage mishaps lately, from running into cars and trees to turning carts over. We want to get these situations under control before someone gets badly hurt.
