Dear BCC Members,

The day has finally arrived! Our new golf professional will be here on Tuesday, August 5, 2025 ready and waiting to join the Brenham Country Club Family! I invite everyone to stop in on Wednesday, August 6th between 10am and 2pm to welcome Sydney and wish her well!

To everyone's delight our new lease carts arrived in July. They have many new features the old carts did not have and they drive a bit faster! Please take good care of them if you use our new BCC carts.

We have also been blessed by an anonymous donor with a beverage cart. It allows for our beverage girls to take a larger variety of drink options and snacks out on the course.

As most members have noticed, the Friends of Golf, MGA and the BCC have upgraded our driving range. We have leveled out the tee box resulting in a larger tee box area, resodded the new tee box and added more concrete to allow for hitting off of 36 mats donated by Blinn. Now we must be patient and let the grass grow to an optimum level of maturity before we can re-open range. Every day is a day closer!

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COURSE CONDUCT REMINDER

Respect the Game. Respect Each Other.

As the season unfolds at **Brenham Country Club**, we'd like to take a moment to reinforce a few important reminders regarding on-course behavior and etiquette. Maintaining the integrity of play and ensuring a positive experience for all members depends on everyone doing their part to uphold these expectations.

Recent Issues Observed

- Bypassing other groups or holes mid-round
- Starting play from holes other than #1
- Ignoring cart path-only signs
- Disregarding pace-of-play and order-of-play

Golf Etiquette Essentials

While not every rule is posted on signs, the game of golf is built on courtesy, integrity, and consideration for others. Please keep in mind:

- **Always wait your turn:** Do not jump ahead of other groups, even if a hole appears open.
- **Follow the tee rotation:** Begin play from Hole #1 unless otherwise directed by staff.
- **Mind your pace:** Keep up with the group in front of you—not just ahead of the group behind.
- **Respect the quiet:** Keep voices down near greens and tee boxes to avoid distracting others.
- **Be ready to play:** Be at or near the tee box 10 mins prior to your assigned tee time.

Cart Guidelines

Proper cart use is vital for preserving course conditions:

- **The 90-Degree Rule** means you must drive along the cart path until you're even with your ball, then turn 90 degrees across the fairway to reach it—then return directly to the path.
- **30-Foot Buffer Zones** around *all greens and tee boxes* must be respected—even if you have a handicap flag. No carts should enter this zone under any circumstance. Obey all **cart path-only** signage when posted.

Marshal Monitoring & Accountability

Our marshals will be active on the course to monitor play, support pace of play, and address any violations. Repeated offenses may result in disciplinary action, including suspension of playing privileges.

Your commitment to these standards ensures the enjoyment of the course for everyone in our community. Thank you for playing your part in honoring the traditions of golf and the values of Brenham Country Club.
